St. Francis Xavier's Religious Education Program

St. Francis Xavier Parish offers a Family of Faith program that has replaced the weekly classes held in the past. Religious Education classes for students are now held only twice per month. Meeting times will be between Masses on Sundays, starting promptly at 9:15am and ending at 10:15am.

Parents are <u>required</u> to attend the first session of each month, and <u>invited but not required</u> to attend the Adult Faith Formation sessions on the second meeting of each month, where we will be viewing "Symbolon: The Catholic Faith Explained" by the Augustine Institute.
